### LEVEL 1 FABRIC SUPPLY LIST

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#### Pillowcase

¾ yard for the Main Piece or Body of Pillowcase (May not want to choose a directional piece meaning the design is all facing one way. Because in the finish project, it may end up laying on its side)

1/3 yard for the band (should coordinate with the main piece)

Thread to match fabric. (I recommend Gutermann (JoAnn's) or the Sew-Ology brand (Hobby Lobby). Please no Coats and Clark. It is not good for the machine.)

#### Messenger Bag

1 3/4 Yard of 100% Canvas Type Fabric including Denim, washable Upholstery Fabric (Not too stiff just something with some body) – Hobby Lobby has a great selection of canvas prints.

Thread to match

1/8 yard of Velcro (if you want a closure)

#### Skirt

Fabric – must be 100% Cotton - 1 yard of fabric will be more than enough for students as long as their HIP measurement is under 33 inches and if they are over 33 inches sound the hips then a 1 ½ yard.

Elastic width – ¾” – 1” wide

Thread to match fabric

1 yard of Tru Grid to make their pattern with – Made by Pellon (Gridded Tracing Material)

#### Personalized Toy

(They will pick out their own animal shape such as a bunny or cat, etc.)

½ yard 100% Cotton Fabric (can be solid or print – if time permits they will learn a little hand embroidery to embellish their choice of animal. Examples: Eyes, nose, flower bouquet.)

Thread to match

2 or 3 skeins of Embroidery Floss in various colors – for the eyes, nose, and any other flower embellishments.

Snack Treats because they work hard. LOL. 😊

Please note that all fabrics must be 100% cotton for the use of ease in learning. I want the child to have the best kind of learning experience and any other types will create difficulties that they are not skilled enough to handle.

I recommend using only a good quality thread to keep our machines in the best working order and keep thread from breaking. Those brands include: Gutermann, Mettler Metrosene, Sew-Ology brand. Please no Coats and Clark.

Consult the Basic Supply List as well for the tools you may want to purchase. Having these items for your child will save time and keep them from waiting to share with other students. Feel free to call me if you have any questions about items you are purchasing. I am always happy to plan a group shopping trip for \$10 per family.
